EWOK Updates

A quick look at the various ventures that were started in the past year and how they fare!

- * Agriculture. EWOK continues to sponsor new agri projects in collaboration with IIT Mandi Medicinal Plant Lab. Visits were conducted to nearby panchayats to recruit interested farmers. 16 families are interested in introducing new crops such as Tegetes for essential oils, rose and other herbs. These crops were chosen based on land suitability as well as presence of industry partners ready to purchase the produce.
- * Bingal Dev Bhoomi Mushrooms has started growing Oyster mushrooms that was well received in the Kamand valley.

- * Neha Devi Laundry Services(NDLS) steps in to fill in a void in laundry services in the area. MDLS is currently providing this service to the South Campus residents of IIT Mandi and is planning an expansion of services.
- * Dharma Beauty & Tailoring Services continues to steadily increase its customer base.



*Balak Rupi SHG was trained to package herbal infusions and assisted in forward integrating with

Thapasu Foods LLC, a

Manali based startup. They will be guided to increase their revenues by increasing value offerings.

* Agni Patal SHG reached out to EWOK for



assistance in marketing their handwoven shawls and caps. EWOK also helped in value addition by connecting them to IIT Mandi faculty to make customized bags with Himachali embellishments for workshops.

For the last several months EWOK has been working towards registration as a society.
